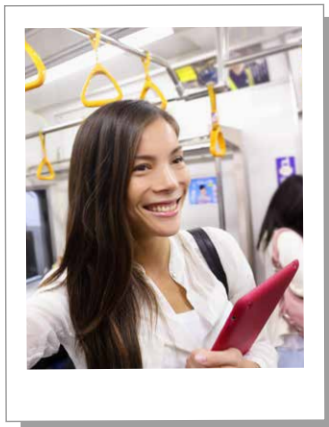

Living in Japan

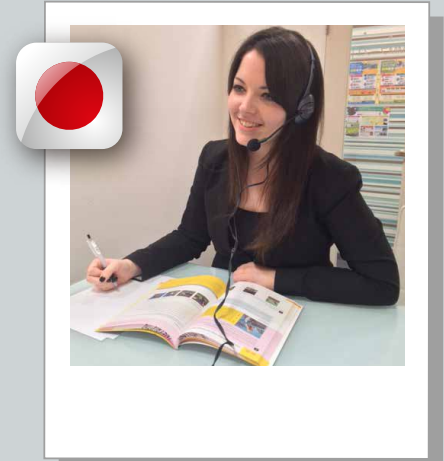

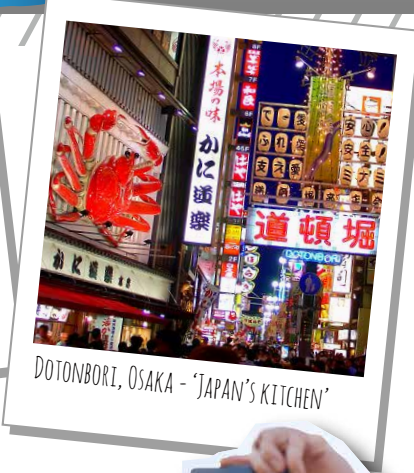
Discover Japan

Whatever has piqued your interest in Japan, anime, zen temples, snowboarding, sushi, you will find all of those things and much much more in this fascinating country.

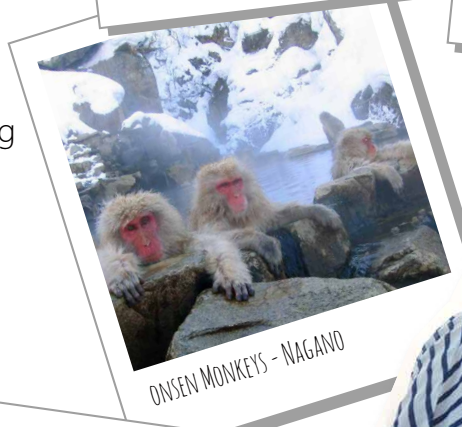

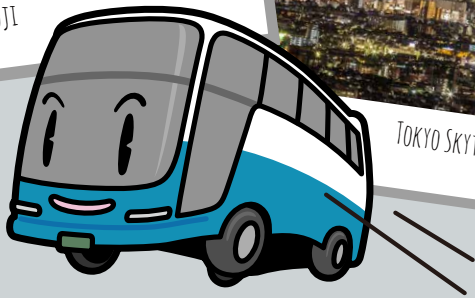

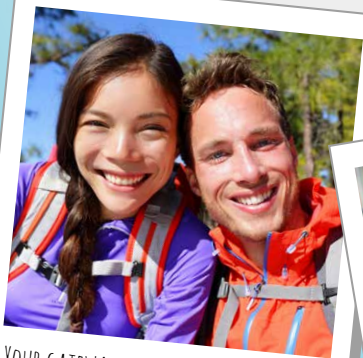
